1. Eligibility Criteria

1. Your Education and Expertise should lie in a Discipline within or closely allied to, the social sciences and the interdisciplinary fields engaged by AJIR in the Areas of Management

Science, Commerce and Economics. A Doctoral Degree in the relevant field is preferred, but not mandatory where the candidate has substantial subject-matter Expertise and Standing.

2. You should have at least [5–7 years] of Experience as an Academician or a Researcher or a Subject Expert or a Practitioner in your field.
3. You should have a reasonable record of original scholarly Publication, Research output, or equivalent Professional contribution that demonstrates familiarity with the standards of Academic Writing and Research.

2. How to Apply

1. Send your detailed Curriculum Vitae (as a PDF), along with the Names and Contact details of two Referees who can attest your Eligibility and Suitability as a Peer Reviewer, to [editor@alameenresearch.org].
2. In your covering note, please indicate your specific Areas of Expertise and 4–6 keywords describing the Topics on which you would be best placed to review manuscripts, so that submissions can be matched to your Expertise.
3. Applications are Reviewed on a rolling basis. The Managing Editor will acknowledge the receipt of your Application and inform you of the outcome within [4–6 weeks].

3. Nature of the Role and Benefits

1. Service as a Peer Reviewer for AJIR is an Honorary position; No Financial benefits/ Remuneration is offered by the Al-Ameen Research Foundation.
2. Reviewers receive a complimentary digital copy of the issue containing any article they have reviewed, and may, on written request, receive a certificate from the Foundation acknowledging their membership of, and the duration of their service on the Roster of Peer Reviewers.
3. Reviewers are expected to complete an assigned Review, ordinarily within [3–4 weeks], following the Guidelines for Peer Reviewers, and to maintain strict confidentiality regarding manuscripts and reviews, as detailed in the Peer Review Policy and Guidelines for Peer Reviewers.

4. Term of Inclusion

1. Inclusion in the Roster of Peer Reviewers is, in the first instance, for a period of [three years]. It may be renewed thereafter on the basis of a mutually satisfactory assessment of service rendered, including responsiveness, timeliness, and the quality of Review Reports submitted.
2. A Reviewer may, at any time, request a Temporary pause or Permanent removal from the Roster by written communication to the Managing Editor.
